Forbo is 100% biogradable and compostable with the lowest LCA (Lifecycle Assessment).

The acceptable color spectrum of Forbo furniture may vary slightly from sheet to sheet.




SCUFF, SCRATCH & BLEMISHES

Forbo surfaces may reveal fine scratches and/or slight abrasions as a result of daily use. Each sheet is unique from one another, but we have seen good color fastness. Forbo will achieve a beautiful patina over time.







MATERIAL CHARACTERISTICS

Surfaces finished with Watson Forbo will obtain a characteristic wear and aging not found in decorative high-pressure laminate (HPL) through scratching, spills, and pen marks. Color and markings will be unique to each sheet and therefore Watson cannot guarantee consistent appearance for all surfaces. Forbo will develop a harder and more beautiful patina over time.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

Forbo may be cleaned with soap and water and non-abrasive cleaners (e.g., Simple Green for tough stains) or Forbo's Monel Cleaner. Stubborn stains may require deeper scrubbing with a brush and natural cleaner. Preventative use of coasters will help avoid stains. Like leather, sharp items may cause scratches. Due to the unique nature of Forbo, it is not covered under Watson's Lifetime Warranty except for defects in delamination resulting from a Watson manufacturing process.
